

WARRANT SPECIAL TOWN MEETING

To: Brian Cote, resident of the Town of Portage Lake, County of Aroostook, and State of Maine

GREETINGS: In the name of the State of Maine, you are hereby required to notify and warn the Voters of the Town of Portage Lake, in Aroostook County, State of Maine, qualified by law to vote in Town affairs, to meet at the Municipal Building in said town on **Wednesday November 20, 2024 at 6:00 (six o'clock) in the evening**, then and there to act upon the following articles to wit:


Note: The Select Board recommends a YES on all budget Articles, unless otherwise noted

- ART. 1 To elect a Moderator to preside at said meeting.
- ART 2. To see if the Town will vote to appropriate \$2,116.36 from Overlay to cover a deficit in the Discounts Department.
- ART. 3 To see if the Town will vote to appropriate up to \$10,000 from Undesignated Surplus for the Fire Department operating account to cover unexpected expenses for overages in payroll and expenses related to correcting Department. of Labor citations, and appropriate \$4,900 from Undesignated Surplus for penalties assessed to the Town from the DOL for citations against both Fire Department (\$3,500) and Public Works (\$1,400).
- ART. 4 To see if the Town will vote to appropriate up to \$16,800 from Undesignated Surplus to cover overages in Insurances for increases in health insurance and IPP due to the hire of a new full-time employee in the spring and increased Town Match for an IRA for 4 employees instead of 3 budgeted for.
- ART. 5 To see if the Town will vote to appropriate up to \$1,500 from Undesignated Surplus to cover anticipated overages in Street Lights due to unexpected electricity rate increases.
- ART. 6 To see if the Town will vote to appropriate up to \$11,000 from the Stumpage Super account to complete improvements to the Seaplane Base to include leveling the building and installing PosTech piles to replace the wooden cribbing currently holding up the building. *Note: This is in addition to the \$5,000 already appropriated at annual town meeting for Seaplane Base improvements.*


Note: Warrant total requested from Undesignated Surplus equals \$33,200..
